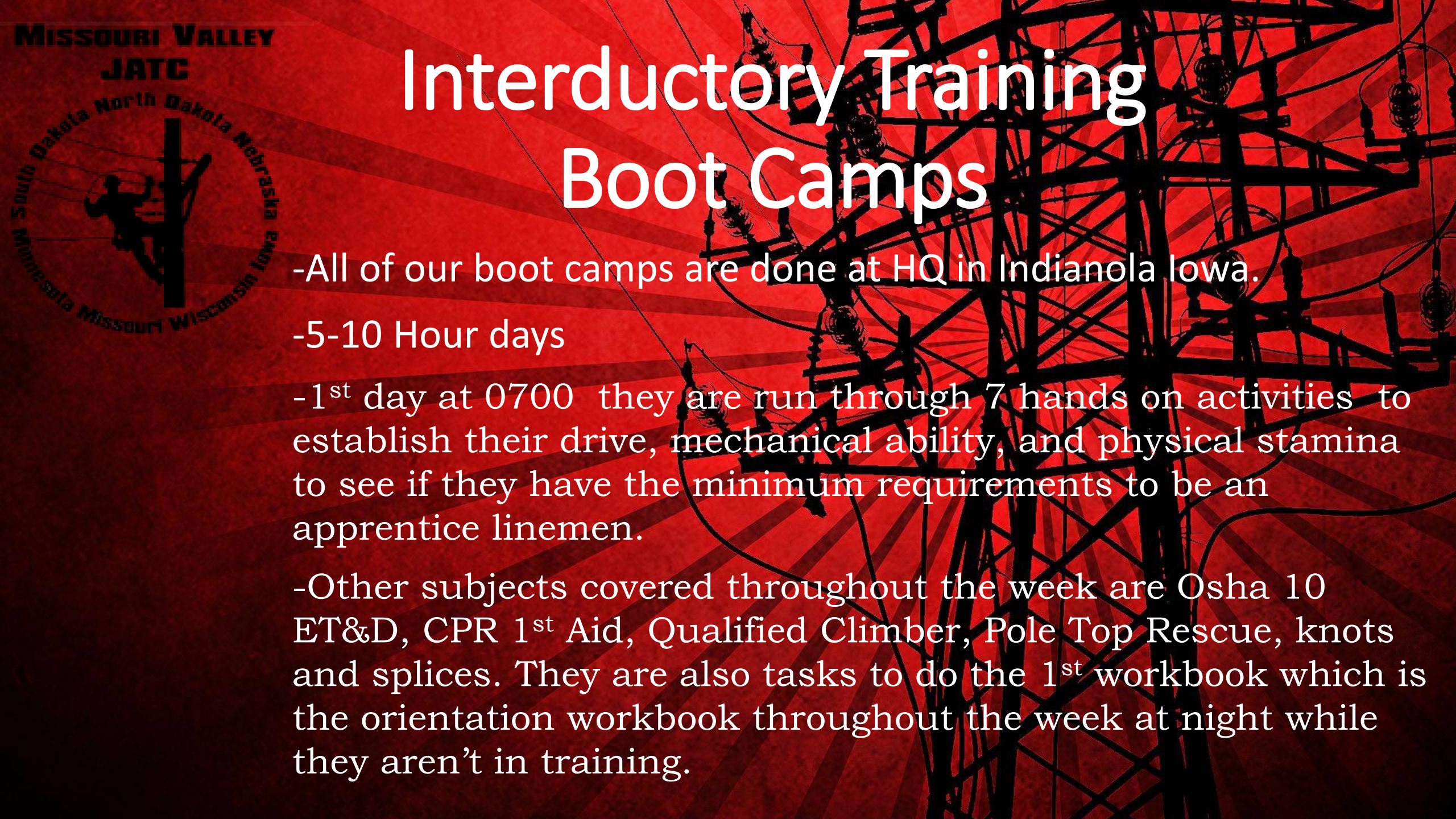

# Interductory Training Boot Camps

- All of our boot camps are done at HQ in Indianola Iowa.
- 5-10 Hour days
- 1<sup>st</sup> day at 0700 they are run through 7 hands on activities to establish their drive, mechanical ability, and physical stamina to see if they have the minimum requirements to be an apprentice linemen.
- Other subjects covered throughout the week are Osha 10 ET&D, CPR 1<sup>st</sup> Aid, Qualified Climber, Pole Top Rescue, knots and splices. They are also tasks to do the 1<sup>st</sup> workbook which is the orientation workbook throughout the week at night while they aren't in training.






After boot camp Apprentices are scheduled every 6 months for a week long class at HQ for a minimum of 10 days per year. Apprentices are also scheduled for additional weeklongs like EICA, Osha 20, and rubber gloving class.



# Rotations of Apprentices


Rotations are handled by our apprentice coordinator and he consistently evaluates all apprentices to make sure they are getting the needed experience they need at each step level.

Missouri Valley requires 800 hot hours  
and hot time is defined as working on  
energized circuits in excess of 600  
volts (whether hot sticking or  
rubber gloving)





Direct Entry is utilized for individuals that have a minimum of 3500 OJT hours working as a Linemen, or an apprentice and wants to apply for apprenticeship. Missouri Valley has step tests established to fully distinguish what step an individual should be slotted into the program at. We also direct enter VEEP and Lazy Q graduates.
