# Academy of Electrical Contracting New Fellow FAQs

As we prepare for the upcoming annual meeting June 4<sup>th</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> at The Wild Dunes Resort in Isle of Palms, SC, we wanted to share some frequently asked questions with Fellows who were inducted in 2024. #### **General Information**

## When can I exchange my red ribbon for a blue ribbon?

 We encourage Fellows who were previously inducted into the Academy to welcome new Fellows who are identified by the red ribbon. After your first Annual meeting, you'll receive a blue ribbon at the next Academy event you attend. Blue ribbons will be available at the Convention. Diane Jacobson can assist with this.

## When should I wear my Academy medal?

- Opening General Session at NECA's Annual Convention
- Academy Reception at the NECA Convention
- Formal Dinner at the June annual Academy meeting

**Note:** You should not wear the lapel pin when wearing your Academy medal.

# What happens if I lose or damage my medal, ribbon, or name badge?

# Is attendance at the annual meeting required to remain a Fellow?

Participation is strongly encouraged to stay connected and involved; however, we
understand that there might be situations where you are not able to attend. Per the
Academy Rules, "Fellows who do not attend three consecutive Annual meetings of The
Academy of Electrical Contracting, will become Fellows Emeritus."

#### What does it mean to become a Fellow Emeritus?

 A Fellow Emeritus may continue to attend all Academy events, although there is no longer a requirement to comply with the responsibilities outlined in Section 6 of the Rules of the Academy. A Fellow Emeritus may return to active status upon written request to, and approval by, the Board of Directors.

## What should I wear to the meetings?

 Yes. We will have a professional on-site photographer at the annual meeting. Casual couples photos will be taken during opening receptions, and formal photos will be taken at the dinner.

# Do I need to register my spouse or guest?

## Can I bring my children to the annual meeting?

 Yes. Children can attend receptions at no cost but cannot attend the formal dinner. You can register children for tours/golf, based on availability.
