



CONCIERGE RECOMMENDED ACTIVITIES SUMMER 2024

The concierge team at the Stein Eriksen Lodge is pleased to welcome you for the summer season!

These are activities around the local area to take advantage of during this wonderful time of year. Please keep in mind that some of these activities are up to an hour away and require transportation. More information on these activities is available through the concierge desk.

Art Galleries – Park City's art community is alive and thriving all year long. Explore all the many art galleries scattered throughout Park City. On the last Friday of every month, enjoy the Park City Gallery Stroll, a free event that gives locals and visitors alike the opportunity to enjoy light refreshments (as available) while exploring Park City's art galleries.

ATV / UTV Adventures – Guided rides are available for single riders on ATVs or up to 4 riders on UTVs. ATV and UTV tours are perfect for friends and family who are looking for an adventure! Explore the Uinta Mountains right outside of Park City on guided/non-guided trails with amazing views and beautiful lakes to cruise by.

Bike Rental – From mountain bikes, electric bikes or cruisers, Park City has you covered! Deer Valley lift access trails are located just right outside of our doors, and Stein Sports will set you up with the perfect bike. Explore the historic Rail Trail in Old Town on an E-Bike! Want to go out with a guide? Let us know and we can set you up with knowledgeable guides that will show you around Park City and beyond!

Deer Valley Chair Lift – Enjoy a leisurely chairlift up the Silver Lake Express from the Snow Park base or the Sterling Express at mid-mountain to the top of Bald Mountain. Explore one of the many hiking trails that wander through Deer Valley or simply enjoy the fresh, alpine air at the top before re-boarding the chairlift for your ride back down. Tickets can be purchased online at deervalley.com.

Deer Valley Concert Series – Bring a blanket and a picnic basket (inquire about ordering) and enjoy some of the biggest names in music on the hill at Deer Valley. With the stunning backdrop and unique amphitheater, there is no better place to indulge in live music. Advanced tickets are highly recommended, shows do sell out.

Fly Fishing – Novice or expert alike, come enjoy some of the best trout rivers in the country! Enjoy a half or full-day with a professional guide on the Weber or Provo River. The guide will provide



transportation, equipment rental, lunch, and all the knowledge and skills to turn you into an experienced fisherman.

Golf - Play one of several courses in the Park City area. Exclusively, the Stein Erikson Lodge is also affiliated with The Promontory Club and can gain access to the private Dye course. There are other excellent public courses in the surrounding area including the Canyon Golf Course, Wasatch Mountain State Park, Homestead Resort, Soldier Hollow, and the Park City Municipal Course.

Hiking - Miles of scenic trails await hikers of all ages and ability levels. Take the chairlift up and take in the breathtaking views of wildflowers and mountains, or hike straight out our doors, a concierge can provide maps and point you in the right direction. Experienced guides are also available to take you on local trails or into the remote areas surrounding Park City.

Horseback Riding - Experience a guided horseback ride. You will ride through beautiful alpine meadows, aspen groves, and pine trees while enjoying breath-taking views. Rides are available in private or group sessions.

Hot Air Balloon Rides - See Park City in a whole new way, peaceful one-hour rides are available in the morning (weather permitting) over beautiful Park City. Truly an unforgettable experience

Indoor Ice Skating - Fun for the whole family at the Park City Ice Arena. This indoor ice-skating rink changes their schedule often so please check with the concierge for open skate times.

Mountain Biking - Whether you're a beginner or pro, we have a trail for you! Stop by Stein Sports for all your rental needs and get on a trail right outside our doors. From lift access to cross country, we can provide a map and direct you where to go. Mountain bike tours and lessons are also available in Park City and surrounding areas. Please inquire about lift times and guide information.

Park City Ghost Tours - Park City Ghost Tours takes you on a 75-minute walking tour of historic Park City sharing ghost stories about the many haunted buildings around Main Street. Tours leave every day from Miner's Park.

Park City Museum - Learn about the history of our mining town inside one of our most historic buildings. Walk into the original jail cells or step back in time, learning of our mining history.

- ***Alpine Slide*** – Slide on a sled down 550 vertical feet on over 3,000 feet of track.
- ***Zip Rider*** – Soar above the treetops at speeds up to 45 miles an hour.
- ***Alpine Coaster*** – Take a ride on the alpine coaster a mile long track of loops & curves.
- ***Children’s Activities Include:*** The Legacy Launcher Trampoline, Miniature Golf, Human Maze, and the Little Miner’s Park Amusement Rides.

Park Silly Sunday Market – Each Sunday, June through September, visit the Park Silly Market held on Historic Main St. Don’t miss out on the live music and unique vender booths that line the street. Everything from arts and crafts, unique gifts, local produce and goods and much more!

River Rafting, Tubing, and Kayaking – Relax and have fun as you float down the Weber River or Provo River. Both rivers offer mild to intermediate rapids and breathtaking scenery. Raft, tube, or kayak for two hours or a half-day with lunch included. Those seeking a more extreme experience should try the tubing!

Scenic Drives and Private Tours – From wildflowers and endless solitude to the majestic Timpanogos Mountains at the Sundance Resort, there are a variety of places to escape to by car. Whether you want to explore for an hour or a day we can find a destination for you. Private tours are available for surrounding areas or even downtown Salt Lake City before you depart home. All tours are custom designed for your interests.

The Spa at the Stein Eriksen Lodge – Graced with European elegance, Utah’s finest Forbes Five-Star spa offers the absolute best in treatments and amenities for the ultimate relaxation. Our concierge can provide you with a spa menu and assist with treatment appointments.

Summer Adventure Camp - Treat your little ones to Deer Valley’s Summer Adventure Camp. Campers will discover a mountain of fun and wonders through adult-supervised and age-appropriate activities like sport activities, nature studies, scavenger hunts, art, and community projects with state-licensed counselors. Daily and Weekly Camps are available June 2 – August 18 (Monday – Friday) Times and prices vary with age.

SUP (Paddle Boarding) – Park City SUP offers daily board rentals at the base of Deer Valley. Lessons and classes are also available, including PCSUP FIT which is a blend of paddle boarding and fitness training as well as yoga. Visit Jordanelle, or of the many lakes in the area and rent boards from the marina, transportation required.



Trap Shooting - Enjoy shooting clay pigeons at a rustic shooting range with two motorized traps, one standard and one wobble, allowing them to cater to amateur or advanced shooters. For those looking for even more of a challenge, a five stand is offered. This is set up as a private event and has an eight-person minimum.

Train Rides - Heber Valley Railroad offers scenic rides through the Provo Canyon Tuesday through Sunday. Comedy Murder Mystery train rides, Sunset Barbeque train rides, and other specialty event trains are available on specific days throughout the summer.

Utah Olympic Park -The Utah Olympic Park hosted 14 medal events at the 2002 Winter Olympic Games and remains a top training facility for Olympic athletes of all kinds! The park offers tours, bobsled rides, alpine slides, zip line rides, luge, and ropes courses. You may even get a chance to observe the athletes in training! Special spectator events are held throughout the summer allowing the public to observe freestyle skiers soar into the air, twisting and turning, before landing in a state-of-the-art 750,000-gallon splash pool.

Water Activities - Wakeboarding, jet skiing, water skiing, paddle boarding, pontoon boats, paragliding, and sailing can be taken advantage of in one of our local reservoirs just 30 - 45 minutes away. Jet Ski, boat, and equipment rentals are also available at the marinas.

Wine Tasting -Our wine cellar at Stein Eriksen Lodge offers access to some of the world's finest wines. Private wine seminars and tastings may be scheduled for up to 10 guests and are led by our sommeliers.

Wellness Classes - Visit our Wellness Studio offering a full schedule of yoga and wellness classes. Classes are taught by certified instructors who care about your well-being. Classes are offered daily and are complimentary for Stein Eriksen Lodge guests. Please inquire about our summer schedule.
