nesses and leisure travelers through a
range of activities, including—
"(I) assisting with the location of
meeting and convention sites;
"(II) providing travel information
on area attractions, lodging accom-
modations, and restaurants;
"(III) providing maps; and
"(IV) organizing group tours of
local historical, recreational, and cul-
tural attractions."; and
(2) in subparagraph (D), by adding at the end
the following:
"(vii) Inclusion of covered busi-
NESS ORGANIZATIONS.—During the cov-
ered period, a covered business organiza-

tion shall be eligible to receive a covered
loan.".
